GATE CODES

Please always remember to enter your code at the seasonal gate when entering the park and the exit gate when leaving. Never give out your gate code.

GOLF CARTS

You must have a valid driver's license to drive a golf cart. Only allow as many people on your cart as there are seats. Use your gate code even when in your cart.

NEAT SITES

Please keep your sites neat and clean. Put stuff away before you leave the park. Please keep your grass mowed and looking nice. We pride ourselves on the maintenance of the park so please help where you can!

DOGS

Dogs must never be left unattended and always leashed. Noisy, unruly, or dangerous dogs will not be permitted to stay in the park. Dogs are not permitted to be in buildings, playgrounds, the beach, or Lucy's Porch. These rules are in place for the protection of our campers but also, we want to keep all the dogs safe. Please be mindful of these rules.



Garbage Bins

Please only put **HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE ONLY** into the bins. NO metal or BBQ's and such are allowed in the garbage here. Please take it to Horn Hill Transfer Station on Hwy 42.

Boat Docks

Please remember that we do not assign boat slips. Please share the marina with all boaters! We do not have enough room for all the boats and toys from everyone so please be considerate and do not use up extra space.

GAZEBOS, DECKS AND FENCES

Green Acres is privately owned land. This means that you may not erect or build **ANYTHING** without direct permission from the park owners. Prior to putting up a gazebo please ask for permission to be sure it gets put in the correct place and is the correct size. The maximum size gazebo allowed is a 10 x 10 and must be placed on your existing deck. If you would like to add on to or build a new deck or build a fence on your deck you need to stop Justin when he is driving in the park or stop at the office to get onto Justin's list.



VISITORS

The office is open from 10-6 daily for visitors to come into the park. The charge for visitors is \$10 per vehicle per day. Do NOT give your gate code out to visitors!

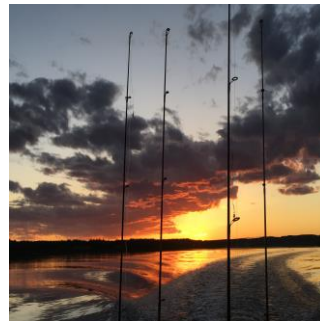
SEWER SYSTEM

When hooking up to our sewer system please be sure to use a 90-degree angle fitting from your sewer hose to the sewer line above ground. Please do not drop your hose down the sewer as it will plug up the sewer.

Please do not put feminine hygiene

products down the sewer as that will eventually cause the sewer system to plug up. Sani-wipes are not flushable.

When dumping the tanks of your trailer we recommend you dumping the black tank first then the grey to clean your hose.
